Check-In-Assessments

This year as a response to all the challenges NSW schools faced during 2020, the Department of Education is releasing some online assessments which schools can use to assist in supporting teachers to plan and inform teaching in the areas of literacy and numeracy. Our school has an opportunity to utilise these free online resources. The tests are not timed because they are a teaching resource which we are pleased to access.

The check-in-assessment is an online assessment for students in Year 3, 5 and 9 and will be available to schools during Term 3. Our Year 5 students will be scheduled to participate in the online tests on Wednesday 2nd September with Year 3 scheduled for Monday 21st September.

This is not a replacement test to NAPLAN and therefore there is no parent report. It is a tool for teachers to use when planning for differentiated teaching and learning programs. The check-in-assessments are designed to supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy, and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs.

School Uniform Survey

Towards the conclusion of Term 2, the school released a survey seeking the opinions of parents regarding commencing the discussion of a possible uniform change at Warrimoo Public School. From this survey the school received 55 responses. Outlined below are the results related to some of the specific questions asked.

1. Would you be interested in further discussion and consultation regarding a uniform colour change at Warrimoo Public School?

Yes – 76.36% No – 23.64%

2. In regards to a colour changes please select the most appropriate box.

No Change to school uniform colours – 20.00%

Bottle green shirts with white panels – 41.82%

Bottle green and white with an introduction of navy blue - 38.18%

3. Would you like to see a unisex sports shirt and short introduced for sports days once a week and for carnivals?

Yes – 74.55% No – 25.45%

4. Would you like to see the boys and girls bottom part of the uniform colour remain the same as it currently is? Boys grey bottom and girls bottle green bottom.

Yes – 78.18%

No – 21.82

5. Would you like to continue to see the summer tunic for girls being available at our school?

Yes - 52.73%

No - 20.00%

N/A - 27.27%

Any decision to make alterations to our current school uniform has not been made, however, due to the results of this survey we will commence the formal stages of consultation with our school and community. Thank you for your support regarding this survey and I look forward to working along-side the P&C moving forward in regards to our uniform.


Each student had to choose a continent to research. They then chose a holiday destination. Here's just a sample of our travel brochures. Where would you like to go?




