

Principal's Report

Dear Parents Caregivers,

COVID-19 Reminders regarding absences

Thank you to all the families that have had their child/ren tested for COVID-19 in response to the changes that were implemented in Week 5 in NSW schools. If your child is displaying any of the following flu like symptoms; fever, runny nose, sore throat, cough or even mild symptoms we strongly recommend your child be tested as confirmation of a negative COVID-19 test will need to be sighted and your child be symptom free before returning to school. If you decide to refrain from having your child tested the Department of Education has updated their guidelines to exclude the child from school for 10 days. Once again, thank you for your ongoing support of our school, as we are all working together to keep the students, staff and community of Warrimoo safe.

Positive Behaviour for Learning – PBL

At Warrimoo Public School we are Safe, Respectful, Engaged Learners. Throughout Week 7 and 8 the staff and students will be focusing on 'taking turns' in the classroom and the playground. By taking turns we develop skills required for all aspects of life; from family, relationships and work. Please echo the message of taking turns with you children at home and together, in partnership, we will support the social development of all students who attend Warrimoo Public School.

Tell Them From Me Survey

This Term, our school will be participating in the Partners in Learning parent survey, another part of the Tell Them From Me suite of surveys (student, teacher and parent surveys) on student engagement. The survey asks parents and carers questions about different factors that are known to impact on student wellbeing and engagement.

Running this survey will help our school understand parents' and carers' perspectives on their child's experience at school. These include: communication between parents/carers and staff, activities and practices at home and parent/carer views on the school's support of learning and behaviour. This valuable feedback will help our school make practical improvements.

The survey is conducted entirely online on smartphones, iPads, tablets, laptops or computers. The survey will typically take 15 minutes or less to complete and is completely confidential. The parent survey will close on 25th October 2020. Although participating in the survey is entirely voluntary, your responses are very much appreciated.

Check-In-Assessments

This year as a response to all the challenges NSW schools faced during 2020, the Department of Education has released online assessments which schools can use to assist in supporting teachers to plan and inform teaching in the areas of literacy and numeracy. Our school is using this opportunity to utilise these free online resources.

The check-in-assessment is an online assessment for students in Year 3, 5 and 9 and is available to schools during Term 3 and Term 4. Our Year 5 students participated in the online tests on Wednesday 2nd September with Year 3 students are scheduled to complete the assessments on Monday 21st September.

This is not a replacement test to NAPLAN and therefore there is no parent report. It is a tool for teachers to use when planning for differentiated teaching and learning programs. The check-in-assessments are designed to supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy, and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs

Well done Shutter Bug students and Ms O'Connor!




2021 School Enrolments


